Case Summary: The Board found that The testimony of the carrier's consulting neurologist, Dr. Sharma, and the carrier's consulting orthopedic surgeon, Dr. Rovner, lacking in credibility, as both doctors disregarded the positive findings made upon examination, and the positive diagnostic tests. Additionally, Dr. Sharma declined to offer an opinion as to degree of disability in regards to the Board Medical Guidelines. In contrast, the Board Panel finds

credible the testimony of the claimant's treating orthopedic surgeon, Dr. Touliopoulos, as the doctor based his conclusion that the claimant had a marked permanent partial disability upon the multiple positive examination findings, the positive MRI results, and the Board Medical Guidelines. Therefore, the Board Panel finds, upon review of the record and based upon a preponderance of the evidence, that the credible medical evidence supports the claimant's classification with a permanent partial disability.

Case Summary: The Board found that Under the circumstances of this case, the WCLJ considered the testimony of the witnesses, noted that the only doctor who testified to the claimant having a neck injury was Dr. Rovner, and found that Dr. Rovner did not indicate in his medical reports that the claimant had an antalgic, or altered, gait. The WCLJ thus concluded that he could not rely on Dr. Rovner's opinion that the claimant sustained a neck injury as a

consequence of a shift in her gait. Here, the Board Panel agrees with the WCLJ and finds that the claimant failed to demonstrate with competent medical evidence that she sustained a neck injury that was consequentially causally related to her back injury. The Board Panel finds that the WCLJ properly declined to amend the claim to include a consequential injury involving the neck. The judgment of the WCLJ was affirmed.

Case Summary: The Board found that At the hearing held on April 12, 2017, the WCLJ found that Dr. Rovner failed to testify and his reports would be given no weight on the issue of causal relationship to the right knee. Also, the WCLJ noted that a chiropractor (Dr. Buurma) cannot make a diagnosis to the knees. Based on the reports and testimony of Dr. Moriarty, the WCLJ found that there is insufficient medical evidence of a causally related right knee

injury and disallowed the claim for a right knee injury, as well as the alleged injuries to the left shoulder, right hand, right hip, and right ankle. The claimant's attorney noted an objection. The WCLJ then awarded compensation from February 7, 2017 to April 13, 2017, and continuing, at a temporary total disability rate of 364.77 per week. The claimant's attorney requested a fee in the amount of 275.00. The WCLJ granted the fee request and designated the case for no further action. These findings and awards were memorialized in a decision filed April 18, 2017, and the current appeal ensued. The judgment of the WCLJ was affirmed.
